- Don't worry too much about strumming. Apart from getting used to where you bung your fingers its moving between chords which is most challenging. Strumming you'll pick up automatically. Take your time you don't need to hit **[G]** the same time as everyone else you WILL improve!
- If theres a song you like that has basic chords, don't be afraid to ask if we can play it but slower. We're proud parents and will be teary eyed when you start pulling off diminished 5ths with ease. No. I don't know what they are either.
- Check the page for 'Bad Moon Rising' it has some more pointers on finger positions and fun stuff luck that.
